

## Results 2016

Overall the students from Blackfriars Academy achieved a very positive set of results which reflects the effort and commitment of staff for all students to do well. Students at all levels achieved accreditation of some sort, ranging from ASDAN Personal Progress, Entry Level 1,2 and 3. A range of Level 1 courses both in BTEC and individual subjects, Level 2 (GCSE) qualifications in which some students achieved a GCSE grade C. So a massive well done to all students this summer, you have done both yourselves and Blackfriars proud.

### Results Highlights:

- All students in Class 3 exceeded their targets. Ends of KS4 data aimed for upper P levels and all attained ASDAN Personal Progress which equates to an EL1 qualification.
- **Year 11 KS4**
- **English :**
- FS English approx 83 % achieved the full or part award. GCSE English students did well with 71.5 % exceeded target and 28.5 % met their target, 100% of all students entered achieved GCSE.
- **Maths:**
- Results showed a marked improvement based upon the predicted data, in GCSE Maths 33 % exceeded their target and 33% met their target, Entry Level Maths 83 % met their target. Cambridge Progression Maths results were generally positive with 81% achieving a full qualification and 19% achieving a part qualification, for the units achieved students were on task to achieve at the required level.
- **Science:**
- GCSE results were good; 25% met their target and 25 % exceeded their target, all students entered for Entry Level Science received accreditation, of which 72% met their target.
- **ICT**
- BTEC ITQ results were a positive move for students to achieve their targets and yet again improved this year, 100% of all students entered achieved a Level 1 Award of which 33% met their targets and 67% exceeded their targets .
- **GCSE History** – all students who were entered achieved a GCSE pass, 50% met their target and 50% made outstanding progress and exceeded their targets.
- **RE:**
- All students passed EL3 RE and GCSE RE achieving a 100% pass rate; of that 100% in GCSE RE 50 % made outstanding progress and 50 % met their target grade; in Entry Level RE 75 % met their target.

- **GCSE Art:**
- All students who were entered achieved a GCSE pass. 12.5 % met their target and 87.5 % exceeded their target.
- **BTEC Creative Media Production:**
- All students passed, 60% exceeded their target and made outstanding progress and 40% met their target.
- **BTEC Home Cooking Skills:**
- All but one student passed, 71.5 % made outstanding progress and exceeded their target achieving a L1 Pass and above, and 28.5 % met their target.
- **BTEC Performing Arts:**
- All students passed, 21% met their target and 79% exceeded their target and made outstanding progress.
- **BTEC Workskills:**
- All students passed, 15% met their target and 85% exceeded their target and made outstanding progress.
- **ASDAN Life Skills Challenge**
- This is a new course for this year and allows staff to create a bespoke curriculum for students; units created this year have been for Creative Media production and History. All students entered passed and all students met or exceeded their target grades.
- **ASDAN PSD**
- This is a new course for this year and has been pitched mainly at our SLD students allowing them to access Entry level 1 and 2 qualifications, of the students receiving the full qualification this year 33% met their targets and 33% made better than expected progress. Of the students achieving unit accreditation 80% met their targets and 20% made better than expected progress.
- **ASDAN Personal Progress**
- All students entered for the qualification passed and 100% met their targets.

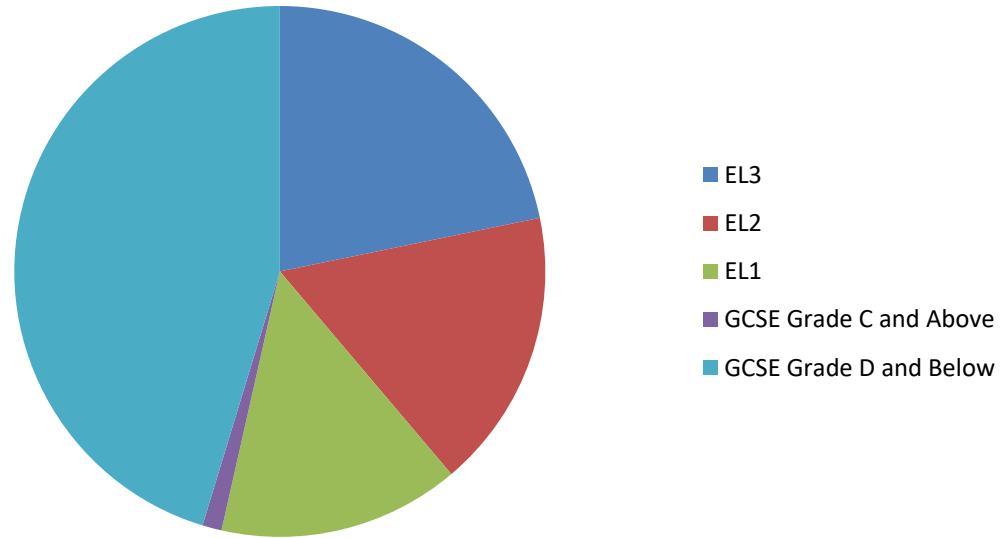
### L1 and L2 (GCSE)

Level 1 equates to a GCSE grades D-G, a Level 1 Award is worth approximately half a GCSE grades D-G, Level 1 Certificate is worth approximately one GCSE grades D-G, a short course GCSE equates to half a GCSE and an Extended Diploma equates to 2 GCSE's.
